

3/5 employees in the UK have experienced mental health issues






















The symptoms are varied and severe

37% have raised blood pressure, dizziness and headaches





Only 1/10 employees disclose their mental health problems to a line manager



And very few utilise Employee Assistance Programmes




One reason is a perceived link to the company






In the real estate industry, mental health issues are estimated to cost around £2,564 per employee







In the professional services industry, mental health issues are estimated to cost around £1,998 per employee








In the retail industry, mental health issues are estimated to cost around £989 per employee
