

# What is the EKW Team's ethos

The ethos of the Education Keyworker service is to achieve positive and lasting improvements and outcomes for children and young people with Special Educational needs across Devon.

### Access to the EKW Team

The service is currently open to all mainstream YP who are SEN K and above in a direct referral route (Referrals to come into us from school or a professional currently working with the YP)

It is a non-statutory service working in co-production with other service e.g., Education, Health and Social care.

We do need parents' consent



# **EKW Intervention**

**6 Week Intervention** (this can be extended if needed) – YP to be seen 3 times per week.

We would aim to see the YP in school if they are attending or at home with an adult present if not, however, it is usually a mixture of both.

#### **Everyone has a part to play in our intervention**

Parents: committed to putting in place all the strategies the EKW have advised.

**School:** reasonable adjustments offered to support the YP's return/increased attendance.

**YP**: a commitment to at least try to return to school/increase their attendance and to follow the advice of the EKW
