'a structured programme which uses random pairing to create an environment supporting and enhancing attainment, relationships and citizenship.'

What is it?

- a way to enable everyone in a class to get on better with one another
 - supportive of personal relationships
 - supportive of learning relationships

- •15-20 minute bursts of activity
 - Once a week for 30 weeks
- Children placed in random pairs
 - •Fun, positive, success-focused

Evaluating the Impact of R Time – Hampton, Roberts, Hammond & Carvalho (2010). Educational & Child Psychology Vol.27 No.1

Statistical Analysis - Rtime had made a significant positive impact on children's development of relationships and friendships and contributed to some changes in children's perceptions of bullying and enjoyment in school

Teachers reported – impact on collaborative working, manners and general social skills
