









# Recently Qualified Teacher Programme

## **Description**

This programme will support teachers in their second year of teaching (RQT's) in continuing to build on an excellent start to their career.

The sessions will provide practical training and guidance which will complement in-school CPD.

This year's programme has been planned specifically to ensure that sessions help to support RQT's who have experienced disruption to their NQT year due to the COVID-19 situation. The programme has been organised into core themes and will be delivered through a series of twilight sessions.

The programme is designed to be responsive to the needs of a teacher who is in the early stages of their teaching career.

## **Programme content**

- Session 1 Reflection on NQT year. Identify next steps / Needs analysis and overview of programme.
  Share the new Early career framework.
- Session 2 Introduction to coaching (use an incremental coaching approach to develop practice further and build on effective relationships).
- Session 3 Development of subject leadership (explore how to be a leader within your setting).
- Session 4 Developing self-regulated learners in the classroom (using metacognition to nurture selfawareness).
- Session 5 Moderation Securing clear judgements through professional dialogue.
